

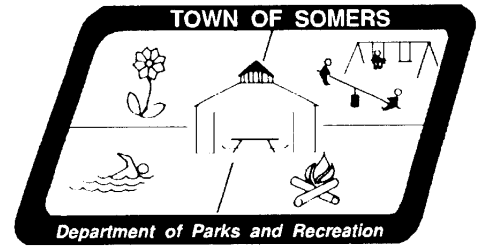

**TOWN OF SOMERS DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION  
FIELD USE PERMIT GUIDELINES**

- All permits must be applied for at least fourteen (14) days prior to the planned use.
- Permits will not be granted for individual use.
- Teams may not have more than ½ of their roster be non-residents. A copy of the roster must be submitted with the permit application including phone numbers and addresses.
- A copy of insurance (see permit) must be submitted with the permit application.
- Permits will be issued for a period of two hours, unless otherwise noted.
- Request for use of lights (if available) will be charged at a rate of \$125.00 per hour.
- All permits are for the sole use of the permittee and may not be transferred to another team/organization. A copy of the approved permit must be available at the site upon request.
- Should the permittee need to cancel for any reason, the Recreation Department must be notified as soon as possible. Failure to do so may result in loss of future use privileges. There will be no guaranteed make-up date due to cancellation.
- The Town reserves the right to cancel use due to inclement weather and/or poor field conditions. If there is any question about the condition of the fields, the Recreation Office must be contacted. Do not assume that fields are playable simply because it has stopped raining. If games are cancelled at Reis Park, all other games will also be cancelled.
- The Recreation Department reserves the right to alter permit times, if needed, to accommodate Town programs.
- Any damage to Town property will result in full restitution to the Town by the permittee.
- The Town of Somers Department of Parks and Recreation reserves the right to suspend, revoke, annul or otherwise terminate any application granted in the event the Department determines that these rules and regulations or parts thereof, are being violated or that there are reasonable grounds to suppose that site property used is being abused.
- All Park Rules (see reverse side) must be followed.

**TOWN OF SOMERS DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION  
FIELD USE POLICY**

All athletic fields are open to the residents of Somers on a first-come, first-served basis. Before the beginning of each season (spring, summer, fall,) all athletic fields under Somers Department of Parks and Recreation jurisdiction are distributed for use to sanctioned (Town sponsored) organizations: SYSA (Somers Youth Sports Association) T-Ball & Baseball, Girls Softball, Boys & Girls Lacrosse, ASYO Soccer, FC Somers Soccer, Flag Football & Tackle Football; Cheerleading, the Somers Men's Softball League and Somers School District teams at the sole discretion of the Superintendent. The Commissioner of each sport schedules practices and games within the times allocated to them.

After all sanctioned organizations have been accommodated, non-sanctioned teams may apply for a permit at the Recreation Office to secure field space, if space remains. In the event that an individual/group is using a field, they must yield to any Town sponsored team, School team or permit holder. Games always take precedence. No other activities are to take place on a field while a game is underway.

If there is any question about field conditions, please call the Recreation Office. Do not assume that fields are playable simply because it has stopped raining. If games are cancelled at Reis Park, all other games will also be cancelled.

All Park rules (on reverse side) must be followed.
