

PARK PAVILION RENTAL RULES

1. The pavilion in Reis Park is available for reservation to residents and businesses located in Somers for a fee. The fee is based on the number of participants in the group using the pavilion. . Reis, Van Tassell, Koegel and Bailey Parks/ facilities are available to Town organizations and resident groups on a permit basis. Permits can be obtained at the Recreation office or by clicking here » www.somersny.com.
2. When you are granted the privilege of using the pavilion, we would like you to keep in mind that other Town residents will also be using the park facilities. A spirit of mutual cooperation by all park participants would be appreciated.
3. The applicant/leader of the group will be responsible for the conduct of all participants.
4. Alcoholic beverages are permitted in Town parks only with an approved permit signed by the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation.
5. A copy of this permit will be issued to you. It should be available for inspection the day of your activity. The Town of Somers police are also given a copy of permits.
6. Key deposit to closet in pavilion to turn on and use electric—\$10.00 cash. If the key is not returned within one week of use of the pavilion, a duplicate will be made and paid for with the deposit, which shall be forfeited.
7. Park rules are affixed to the front of the pavilion and must be observed. They will be enforced. Abuse of the rules may result in forfeiture of future reservation of the pavilion.
8. Parking by all participants should be done in the provided parking areas. No vehicles are allowed on the walkways to the pavilion.
9. In the event of cancellation, please inform the Recreation office as soon as possible. Many times a wait listed group will be able to use the vacated date. Fees are non-refundable.
10. In case of emergency, call the New York State Police at 911. For non-emergency issues, call the New York State Police at 277-3651.
11. Permit holders must clean up the area used before the termination of the activity. If tables are moved, they must be returned to their original location under the pavilion.
12. Trash should be bagged and removed from the premises by the permit holder.
13. There is a permanent grill located on the far side of the pavilion. Please make sure that all charcoal fires are completely extinguished before the end of your activity.
14. The Town of Somers Department of Parks and Recreation reserves the right to cancel any permit, with a refund of all fees paid, if questions arise regarding the validity of the intended use or if the facility is needed for a Town-sponsored event.
